In 2009, the Environmental Resources Training Center (ERTC) at SIUE installed a 32kW photovoltaic array on its roof and a 20 kW wind turbine adjacent to the building. The ERTC operates a training scale water treatment plant that trains students to become water treatment operators, supervisors and managers. In addition to providing a portion of the facility's electric load, the wind turbine and photovoltaic system also educate students about the use and benefits of renewable energy.

The two systems complement each other, with the photovoltaic array generating most of the power in the summer and the turbine generating most of its power between November and May. As of December 2013, the solar panels and wind turbine have saved over \$10,600 in electricity costs. The savings have helped to fund the maintenance and repair of the facility.
