

## Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation Natural Areas Land Acquisition Grants 2013-2017



## 2013-2017

52 land acquisition grants were awarded to protect natural areas at the 57 sites shown on this map. They total 6,462 acres of habitat owned outright and 350 acres protected via conservation easement.

The map also includes three natural areas, totaling 473 acres, that were purchased between 2013 and 2017 but supported by a multi-year grant to Ducks Unlimited awarded in 2012.

14 of the sites included in this booklet are part of the Illinois Nature Preserves System. More may be added into the system after the publication of this booklet.





## **Additional Information**

The grants awarded from 2013 - 2017 represent a total commitment of \$22.4 million by the Foundation, which leveraged an estimated \$31.1 million in matching funds from grantees and other sources.

When completed, the projects will have led to the overall protection of over 6,800 acres of natural areas and wildlife habitat.

Grantee organizations are listed in color. The project sites are organized by year and listed alphabetically by county.
